Generating funding via proposals to the provincial government along with other fundraising was a key part of making the agency successful.

Cheryl & I have been residents of the park for 7 years. I served on the Activity Club Board for 4 seasons as Vice President and President. That was an excellent introduction to the park and the residents, the best part was being close to all the fun stuff at Pine to Palm.

I have a Business Administration degree that allowed me to function very well in a wide range of business, including some where I had no practical experience. Working with employees, co-workers, superiors, customers, folks with disabilities and volunteer board members was a constant in my life. My people skills are very well developed, along with my business experience I believe I am extremely capable of serving the Pine to Palm community.
